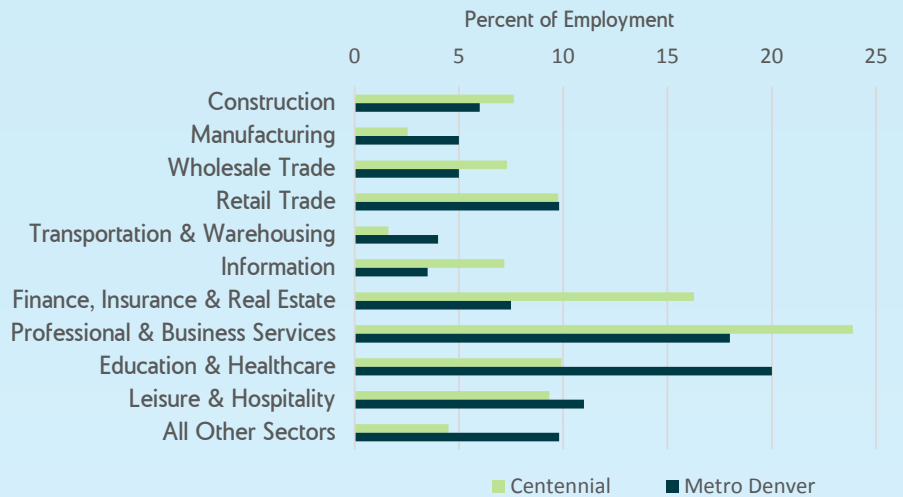

2018 MAJOR CITY PROJECTS

INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM MASTER PLAN

The Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Master Plan will install travel time monitors, improve traffic signal detection, connect all traffic signals to the master system and implement upgrades to the existing master system software. The budget allotted for the ITS Master Plan is \$1 million for 2018.

SIDEWALK PROGRAM

In 2018, \$575,000 is included in the Capital Improvement Fund for the construction of new or missing sidewalk segments throughout the City. Specific locations will be identified based upon prioritized need and other available funding sources.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN (CENTENNIAL NEXT)

The City has allocated \$150,000 to develop a new comprehensive plan, Centennial NEXT, to help ensure the community's values align with the City's road map for development. This City-wide plan will promote quality of life, sense of community, economic vitality, supporting infrastructure and a responsible government that leaves a legacy for future generations.

EAST WEST TRAIL

The City's Open Space fund has allocated \$130,000 for the design of the East West Trail. This design will connect approximately 17 miles from the High Line Canal Trail to Piney Creek Trail (and a continuous connection between E470 and the South Platte River Trail). Currently there is no trail connecting the west and east sides of the City of Centennial. Design will take place in 2018. Construction is to be determined.

FIBER MASTER PLAN

The implementation of the City's \$5.7 million Fiber Master Plan is underway. City Council has created the Centennial Fiber Commission to oversee Centennial FiberWorks, the program administering the implementation of the City's fiber backbone. This backbone will make fiber available to key City sites and other community anchor institutions.
