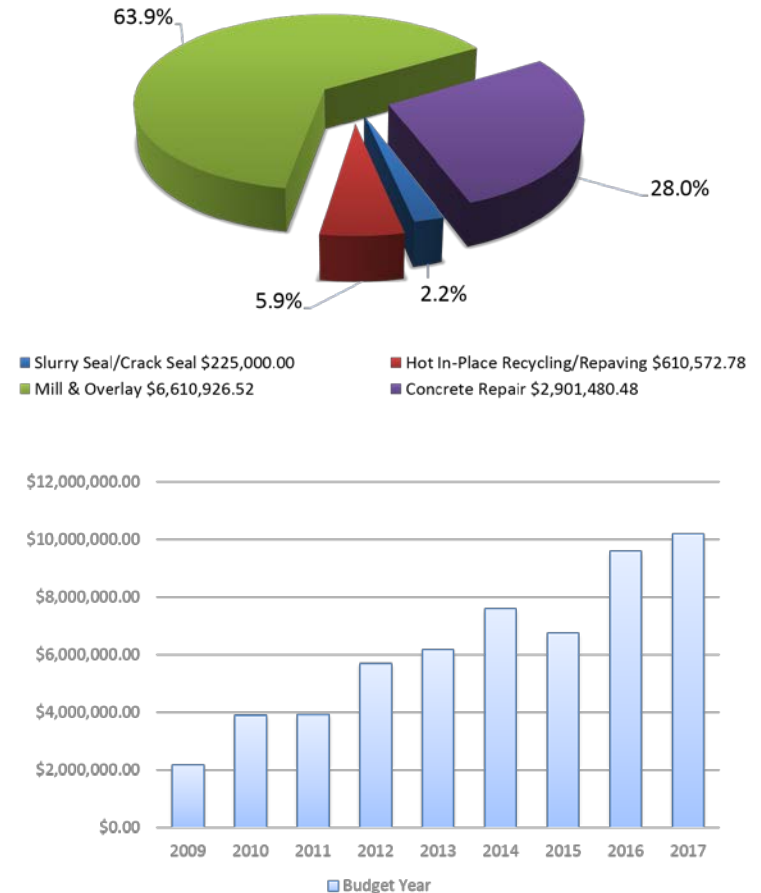
# Increase in Snow Plowing Level of Service

- Council increased level of service, resulting in concurrent plowing on major (Priority 1) and minor (Priority 2) snow routes
- Result of feedback from Citizen Survey
- Plow major and minor arterials simultaneously
- Six or more inches – residential plowing



# Street Rehabilitation

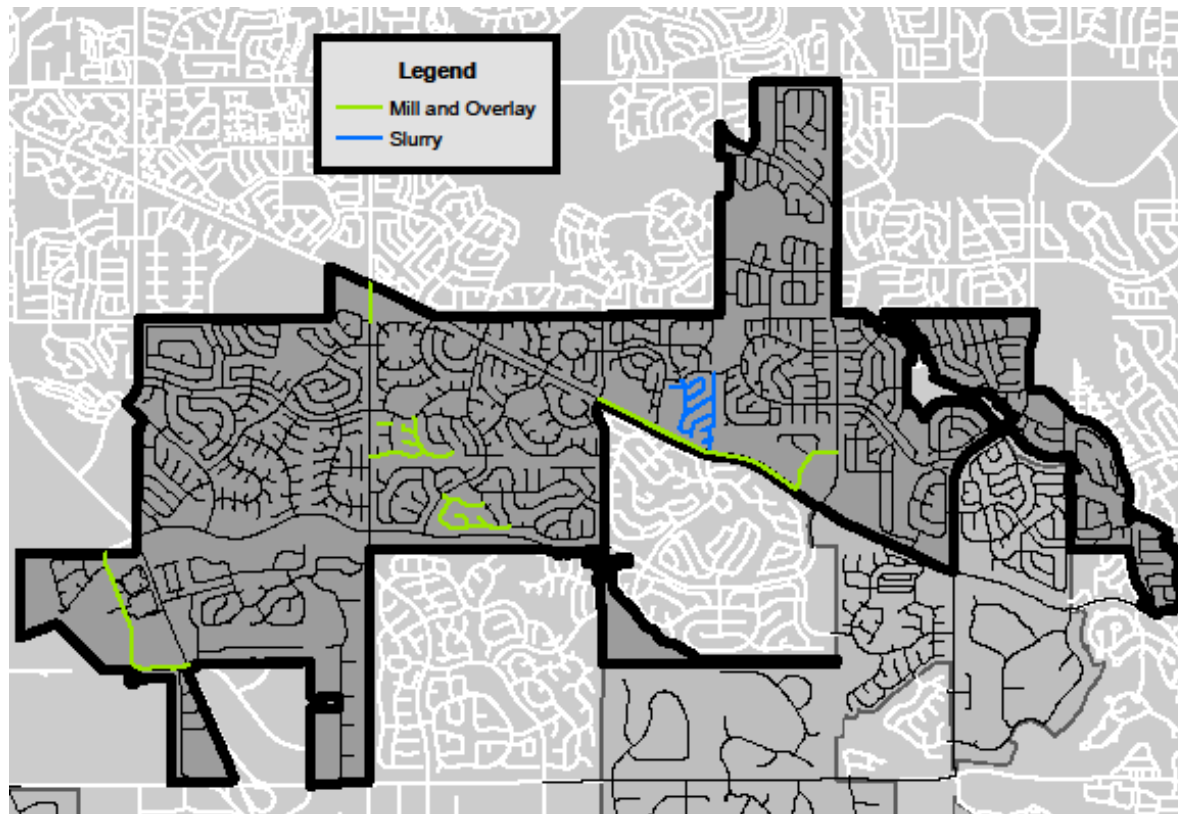
- Council increased funding (\$10.2 M in 2017) to address residents' concerns with pavement condition
- Concrete replacement
  - March 7 – August 15
- Slurry Seal
  - May 15 – September 15
- Mill & Overlay
  - March 27 – October 27





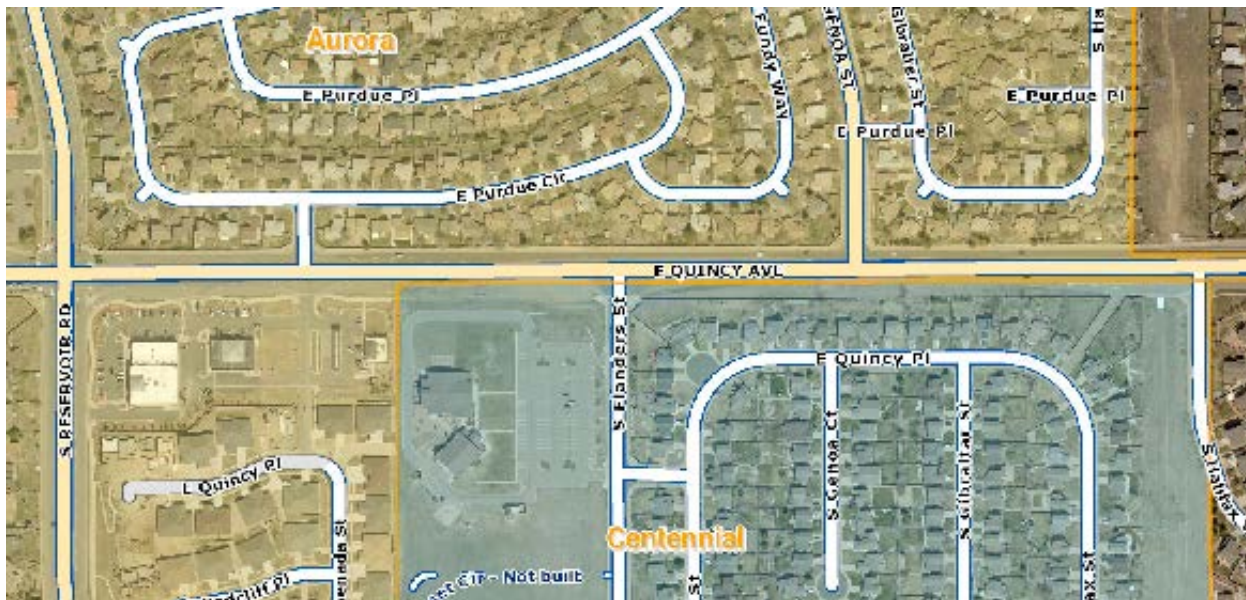
# Street Rehabilitation

# Quincy Ave. Widening

- Roadway widening to complete multi-lane street section between Reservoir Rd and Halifax Way
- Joint project with Aurora
- Design in 2017; construction anticipated in 2018



# Smoky Hill/Himalaya Improvements

- Design summer; construct by end of 2017
- Project adds westbound right-turn and left-turn lanes, northbound left-turn lane and raised median on west leg of intersection
